1 WHAT SERVICES DOES WILLOW BROOK OFFER?

Between our three Willow Brook campuses, we offer independent living, assisted living, transitional living, memory care, adult day care, skilled nursing care, short and long-term rehabilitation, and respite.

2 CAN I DOWNSIZE TO A RETIREMENT COMMUNITY AND STILL MAINTAIN MY INDEPENDENCE?

4 WHAT IF I AM NOT SURE WHAT LEVEL OF CARE IS NEEDED?

Our professional staff will talk with you one-on-one about your activity level, mobility, health issues, and any other current concerns. Our nurse will also conduct a wellness assessment to determine if there are any care needs. Resident care is our top priority.
